Are You Being Evicted? Select Your County to Get Legal and Financial Help

During the COVID-19 pandemic, courts, legal aid, and local Housing Assessment and Resource Agencies (HARAs) are working together to help people facing eviction. This help includes:

- Free legal help from your local Legal Aid to protect your rights during the eviction process;
- Financial assistance from your local HARA to help cover back rent owed for March, April, May, June, and July;
- An extra pre-trial **hearing** to give you time to work with Legal Aid and HARA to try to resolve the case with your **landlord**.

Select your county and you will find a phone number and/or online intake link for Legal Aid; the phone number for local HARA; and possibly, an intake number that both HARA and Legal Aid are using. You can use any of the resources listed, although we suggest using online intake if you are here outside of regular business hours of Monday-Friday, 9am - 5pm.

Whether you have a **[Notice to Quit](#)**, **[Demand for Possession](#)**, or **[Summons](#)** for court, call or apply for help right away. The sooner you do this, the more likely you'll get help and avoid being evicted.
